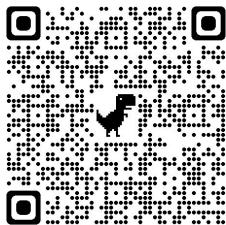

and with God's humble care.

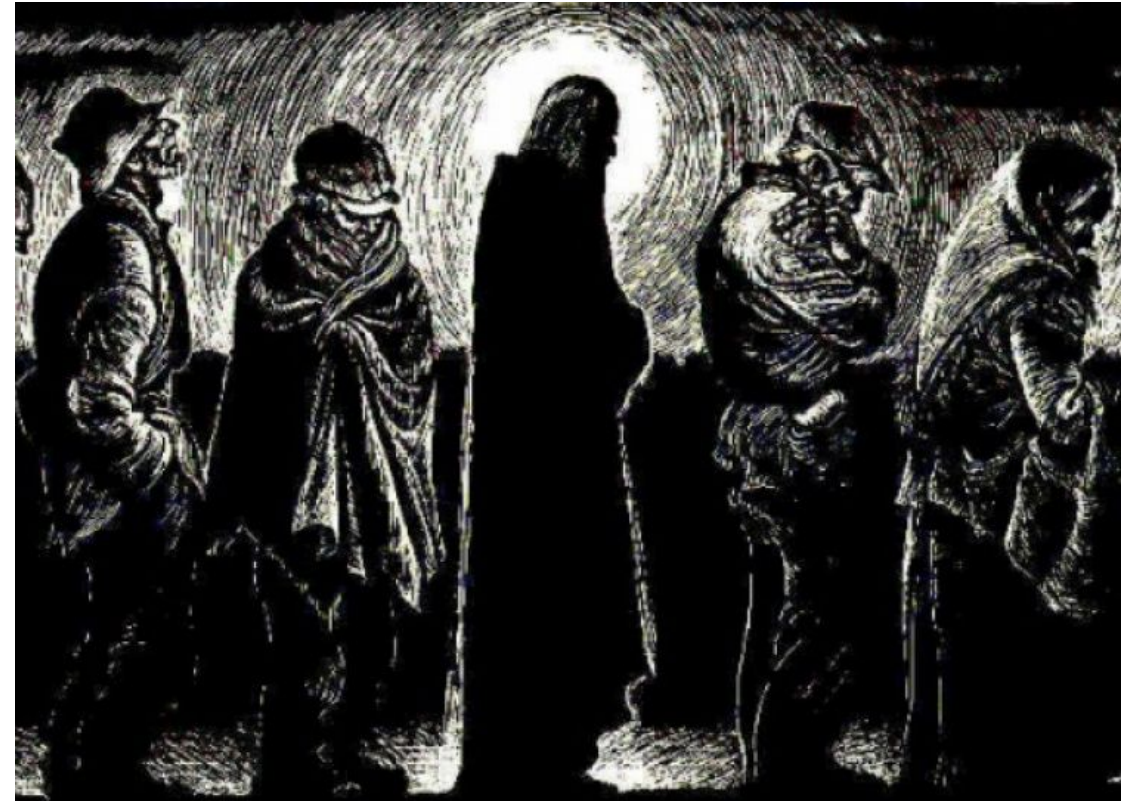
