


We are an imperfect community striving to live into the beautiful story of God in our wonderful yet broken city. We invite you to join us as we seek God's glory and neighbor's good together!

- Children are welcomed and encouraged to join us in the worship service. During the summer, we provide a nursery for infants (unstaffed) on the main floor and childcare for toddlers in the basement for the duration of worship. There is also a "quiet space" in the back of the sanctuary where children are welcome to play.
 - Pre-K Activities: Following the Passing of the Peace, Pre-school through Kindergarten aged children are invited to line up in the Narthex for class lasting until communion.
- "Praise Ye the Lord, Hallelujah" is a rendition of Psalm 150 by J. Jefferson Cleveland. As his biography on hymnary.org notes, Cleveland "was one of the most important scholars and editors of African-American congregational song of the 20th century." He was one of the co-editors of the groundbreaking African-American hymnal *Sounds of Zion* (1981).
- "He Leadeth Me" was written by Joseph Gilmore while he was serving as his father's secretary (the governor of New Hampshire) during the Civil War. As he noted, "It was the darkest hour of the Civil War. I did not refer to that fact—that is, I don't think I did—but it may subconsciously have led me to realize that God's leadership is the one significant fact in human experience, that it makes no difference how we are led, or whither we are led, so long as we are sure God is leading us."
- The bulletin art is entitled "The Foxes Have Holes" by English artist Stephen Spencer.

Ordinary Time is the span of the church calendar that runs between Eastertide and Advent. It received its name not because of its ordinariness, but from the word "ordinal" which simply means counted. It is the time also known as the Season of the Church where we celebrate the growth and mission of the Church through the work of Christ. Because the themes of growth and new life are so prevalent, the color of the season is green.
