the precious Lamb of God.

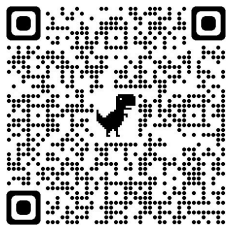
2. Holy is the Lamb,
