### SONG\* - At the Table

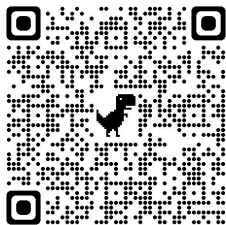
At the table, none are finished,
