come and feed our hearts, O Lord.

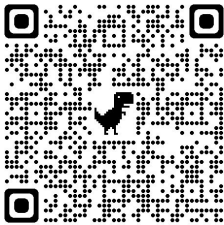
2. Quench us, Lord. Quench us, Lord.
