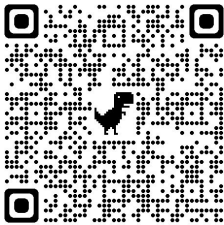

SONG* - At the Table

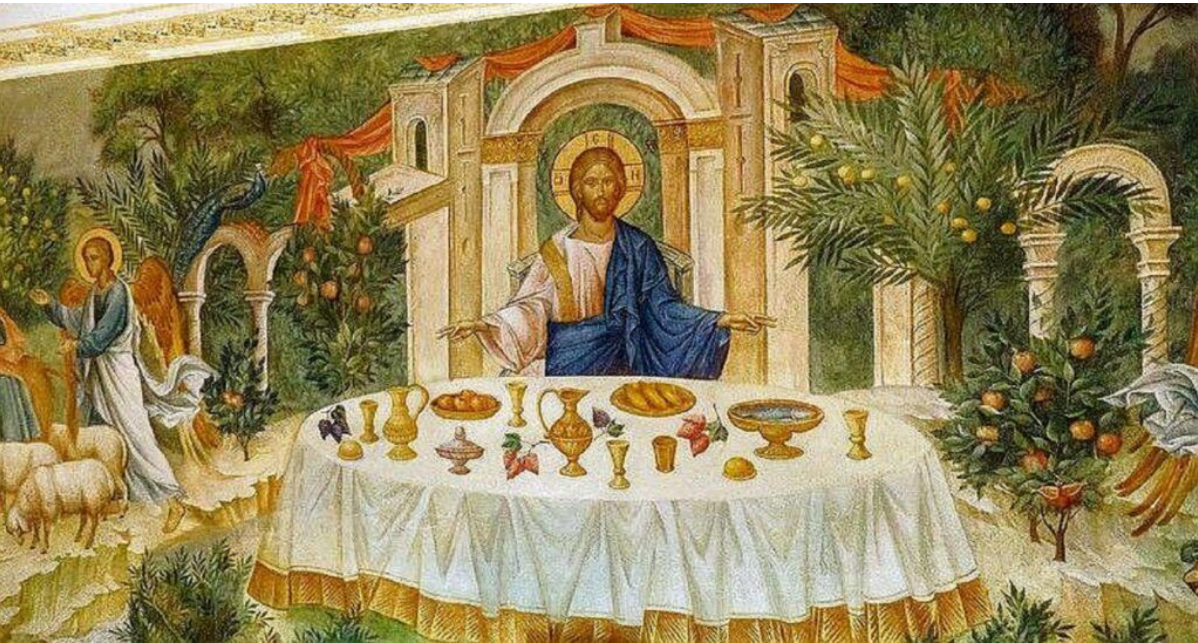
