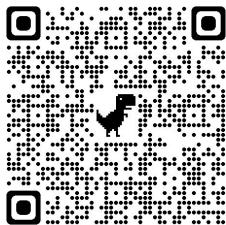
SONG* - One Bread, One Body (#570)
