SONG* - I Need You to Survive

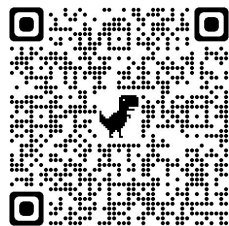
I need you, you need me,
