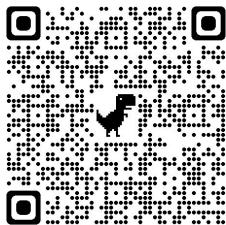
SONG* - Come to Me, O weary Traveler
