### SONG\* - All Who Are Thirsty

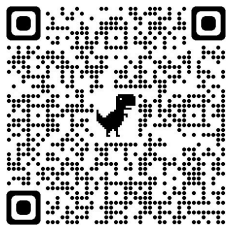
All who are thirsty,

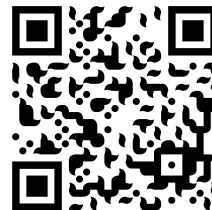
