SONG* - One Bread, One body (#570)

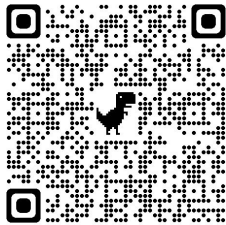
Refrain
