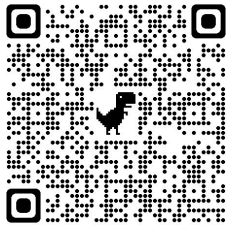
### SONG\* - O the Deep, Deep Love of Jesus
