### SONG\* - We Come Now to Your Table

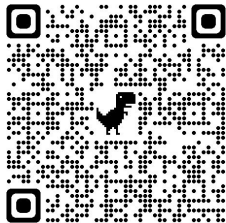
We come now to your table, Lord,
