SONG* - Enviado Soy de Dios

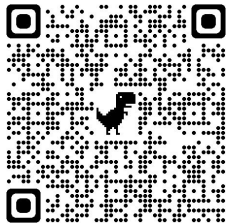
Enviado soy de Dios,
