SONG* - What the Lord Has Done in Me

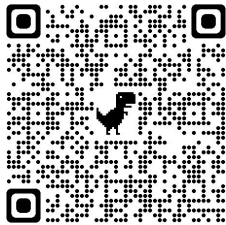
Let the weak say, "I am strong."
